



The **Institute for Mathematics** at the **University of Würzburg** invites applications for a

Junior Professorship (W1) in Mathematics
(3 + 3 years with option for tenure track)

commencing as soon as possible. We are looking for a candidate who works on theory or numerics of partial differential equations with interconnections to other fields of mathematics and who is able to cooperate with the applied sciences.

Part of the duties of this position are teaching in Bachelor and Master courses as well as teacher's training and other service activities within the Institute for Mathematics. Furthermore, it is expected that the applicant will partake in the post graduate program of the University. The University of Würzburg attaches great importance to the intense supervision of students and doctoral candidates and expects a high commitment to that effect.

Prerequisites for this position are a university degree, teaching skills at university level and a competence for an academic career, usually evidenced by the excellent quality of a doctoral degree.

If the applicant was employed as a research assistant either before or after obtaining the doctoral degree, the entire duration of the period of employment both before and after the doctoral degree should not exceed six years.

The position is a fixed-term professorship for the duration of three years. In the case of a positive evaluation the position may be extended for another period of three years. After the second period the appointment may be converted to a tenured W2-professorship given a suitable qualification.

The University of Würzburg wishes to increase the share of women in areas where they are underrepresented and strongly encourages women to apply. Furthermore, disabled candidates with essentially equal qualifications will be given preference.
